Anyone is welcome and no documentation is required. Of course, masks should be worn (and for those whom need them we'll be offering masks along with groceries, as supplies allow).

Even if you don't feel that you're "in need," you are welcome and encouraged to come by and partake of the local organic produce, bulk staples, and other items that are shared. It can be a way to cut down on grocery-store trips and redirect some of your resources to local mutual aid efforts.
